Morning and Aftertoon Playgroup

Monday - Friday 630-8:00 am and 2:00-4:00 pm

For parents needing to drop their child off earlier or pick up later, BTB will provide a morning and afternoon playgroup. During this time, children will engage in sports, arts and crafts, play and receive homework help all under the supervision of one of our staff. Breakfast can be brought in during the morning playgroup and snacks can be brought in, or purchased from our snack cart, for the afternoon. Playgroup will open at 6:30 am and close at 4:00 pm. Prices are as follows:

Morning - Monday - Friday	Afternoon - Monday - Friday

Students can participate and/or be dropped off early on an unscheduled basis for \$25 for the morning and \$35 for the afternoon. 24 hours notice is required to assure we have a staff member available.

POLICIES

Monthly tuition:

- Payment for September is due upon entering the program. All consecutive payments from October to June are to be paid on the 1st of the month. Biweekly payments are an option with payments made on the 1st and 15th of the month.
- Payments must be made preferably in cash, or we will accept a check, made out to Beyond the Books.
- In the event that the 1st falls on a day BtB (or your child's class) is not in session (For example, if the 1st falls on a Saturday) payment is due on the previous Friday. If your child does not come to school on Tuesday and the 1st is a Tuesday, payment should be made the previous Monday.
- A full month's payment is due every month from September to June regardless of the number of days off. Payment will NOT be prorated or refunded due to winter break, spring break, vacations, sick days, snow days or in June when we are only in session for half of the month.

^{*}Any other schedule requests and payments must be discussed with Nicole or Holly.

^{*}If your child comes for a partial day or week and you need to add a day due to unforseen circumstances, you can notify the manager with 24 hours notice and pay \$40 for a half day or \$60 for a full day.

• Late payments will not be tolerated. In the past we allowed a grace period; however, this was happening too often and affecting our ability to pay rent on time. Late payments will be met with an additional late fee. See below.

Before and After care playgroup policies:

- Payment must be made with your monthly payment on the 1st of the month.
- If you commit to 2 days for example, that is what you pay for the month, regardless if you do not need it on certain days, your child is absent or there is a holiday. No refunds will be given; however, if your child missed a day and you'd like to make it up, please speak to the director or the manager to arrange this.
- Children can add an unscheduled day for a small fee but 24 hours advance notice is required.
- The payment is for the hours available and does not matter if your child gets dropped off after 6:30 or picked up before 4:00

Family Discount:

- 1st child, full membership
- 2nd child, 10% off membership *Discount applied to the child at the lower rate
- This policy also applies to the payment made for before and after playgroup

Calendar:

• Beyond the Books has our own calendar; however, we try to follow the Manalapan Englishtown Regional School District calendar as closely as possible for holidays and weather events, etc.

Penalties for Late Dues: (a grace period day will NO longer be accepted)
Unless there are extenuating circumstances that are communicated prior to payment days, late payments are no longer tolerable.

- 1 day late, \$40
- 2 days late, \$80
- 3 days late, membership privileges are revoked until full payment (penalty + normal tuition) is received.

Penalties for Late Pick ups:

We understand that things come up and traffic occurs; but some of our staff have to leave on time due to children or work obligations; therefore, regular late pick ups will be received with a fine after the first one. There will be a 15 minute grace period and all children should be picked up no later than 2:15. (This applies to late pick ups that are happening on a regular basis. Sporatic late pick ups will be at the manager's discression)

- 1st late pick up after 2:15 free
- 2nd late pick up after 2:15 10
- 3rd late pick up after 2:15 20
- \$10 is added to each late pick up after that

Penalty for Returned Checks:

• BtB reserves the right to charge \$30 for returned checks.

Health concerns:

Beyond the Books is NOT a peanut free association. If this is a concern for you and your child, I advise you to seek a more suitable place of education that will be able to better protect their needs.

Class Cancellation:

- Beyond the Books reserves the right to cancel and/or modify the class or time depending on enrollment.
- If a class is canceled, dues associated with that class will be refunded.

Refunds:

• No refunds for days missed for illness, vacations or weather.

Mid-year / Mid-month enrollment

• If you enroll your child in the middle of a month during our academic year, membership for that month will be prorated. It will be divided by the number of academic days in that month to give you the amount you will pay per day until the end of the month. This amount will be paid in one payment upon enrollment.

Termination:

- Written notice is required to terminate membership, effective immediately. No refunds will be given. Exceptions are at the discretion of the director.
 - EARLY TERMINATION: If a member is moving or needs to withdraw membership prior to the Fall 2024 session, written notice is required. Upon withdrawal, 50% of September's dues will be refunded since curriculum materials had already been ordered for that child.

Beyond the Books reserves the right to accept, reject or terminate a family (or learner) that is not in the best interest of the program. Every reasonable attempt will be made to connect the family with a facility that is better suited for the child's needs in the least restrictive environment.

Membership Agreement/Waiver Form

Overview: I do hereby apply for membership in Beyond the Books Education LLC. With the signing of this membership agreement, I accept the offer made to become a member of Beyond the Books and have read and agree with everything presented to me in the handbook and agree to the following:

Declaration of Purpose: The purpose of Beyond the Books is to operate a private education program for families who wish to homeschool their children but for many reasons are unable to do so. As a member of Beyond the Books, your privacy and choices will be respected. We are dedicated to the education of the whole child and the right of the family to determine the course of that education.

Beyond the Books founders and Beyond the Books Members (parents and children) can freely share, discuss, and exchange information and services by members of Beyond the Books while keeping all business within the private domain.

Membership: By consenting to the Membership Agreement provided, members are granted the following rights and benefits:

- Right to detailed informed consent about the services rendered, and what to expect.
- Guarantee that all personal information of the Member will remain within Beyond the Books.
- Membership with Beyond the Books will remain intact unless the member submits in writing their desire to withdraw membership or membership is terminated by The Association in accordance with bylaws.

IT IS DECLARED that we proclaim the freedom to choose for ourselves the type of education philosophy that we think best. We encourage our members to perform their own research by studying different educational philosophies for the development of the child.

Specifically, the mission of Beyond the Books is to provide a safe and nurturing environment for the child to grow and to thrive, unfettered by external pressures of the public domain. Beyond the Books will utilize experienced educators to provide a curriculum outlined in the specific course materials or education philosophies.

- I understand that Beyond the Books Education is a legally formed LLC in the state of New Jersey and is NOT a school; therefore, I maintain the privacy of the group and may not use Beyond the Books as a tax write off because we do NOT qualify as a school nor are we a child care facility.
- As I am voluntarily choosing this method of education and service providers, I will not hold The Association or its members financially liable for any particular outcome.

I agree to join Beyond the Books Education, a private membership program under common law, whose members seek to help each other achieve better health, education, and good quality of life.

My activities within Beyond the Books Education are a private matter that <u>I refuse to share</u> with the State or local Board of Education or other governmental regulatory agency without

express permission from Beyond the Books Founders. All records and documents remain as property of the Association, even if I receive a copy of them. I fully agree not to pursue any course of legal action against a fellow member of the Association, unless that member has exposed me to a clear and present danger of substantive evil, and upon the recommendation and approval of the Association.

I enter into this agreement of my own free will without any pressure or coercion. I affirm that, as a private member I do not represent any Local, State or Federal agency whose purpose is to regulate and approve products, services, or practices, or to carry out any mission of enforcement, entrapment, or investigation. I have read and understood this document, and my questions have been answered fully to my satisfaction. I understand that I can withdraw from this agreement and terminate my membership in this association at any time, and that my membership can and will be revoked if I engage in abusive, violent, menacing, destructive or harassing behavior towards any other member of The Association. These pages consist of the entire agreement for my membership in The Association.
