We strive to develop the whole human being in order to help each child reach their intellectual, emotional, social, creative and inquisitive potential.



Beyond the Books Education is an LLC dedicated to providing private education based upon a broad and balanced curriculum that bridges the gap between homeschool and traditional school. At Beyond the Books, we have faith in educating the child; the whole child. BtB tailors instruction to meet the needs of each individual learner. We have a firm belief that each child learns differently. When children are kinesthetically engaged, their learning is more profound.

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MEMBERSHIPS

Membership dues must be paid by the 1st of every month preferably in cash, or we will accept a check, made out to Beyond the Books. Biweekly payments are an option with payments made on the 1st and 15th of every month.

POLICIES

Monthly Membership fee (also referred to as tuition):

- Due upon acceptance into the program and paid every month thereafter until June
- Paid in cash (preferably) or check to Beyond the Books
- Can be paid in full by the 1st day of the month or
- Can be paid bi-weekly: 1st and 15th of the month
- Must be paid on or before the 1st in the event that the 1st falls on a day BtB (or your child's class) is not in session. For example, if the 1st falls on a Saturday, payment is due on the previous Friday or can be paid on the 1st by dropping it off at my home.
- We are unable to set up electronic payments at this time.
- A full month's membership is due every month from September to June regardless of the number of days off. Membership will NOT be prorated or refunded due to winter break, spring break, vacations, sick days, snow days or in June when we are only in session for half of the month.

Family Discount:

- 1st child, full membership
- 2nd child, 10% off membership *Discount applied to the child at the lower rate

Calendar:

• Beyond the Books has our own calendar; however, we try to follow the Manalapan Englishtown Regional School District calendar as closely as possible for holidays and weather events, etc.

Penalties for Late Dues: (a two day grace period will be accepted)

- 2 days late, \$40
- 4 days late, \$40
- 5 days late, membership privileges are revoked until full payment (penalty + normal tuition) is received.

Penalty for Returned Checks:

• BtB reserves the right to charge \$30 for returned checks.

Health concerns:

Beyond the Books is NOT a peanut free association. If this is a concern for you and your child, I advise you to seek a more suitable place of education that will be able to better protect their needs.

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Class Cancellation:

- Beyond the Books reserves the right to cancel and/or modify the class or time depending on enrollment.
- If a class is canceled, dues associated with that class will be refunded.

Refunds:

• No refunds for days missed for illness, vacations or weather.

Mid-year / Mid-month enrollment

• If you enroll your child in the middle of a month during our academic year, membership for that month will be prorated. It will be divided by the number of academic days in that month to give you the amount you will pay per day until the end of the month. This amount will be paid in one payment upon enrollment.

Termination:

- Written notice is required to terminate membership, effective immediately. No refunds will be given. Exceptions are at the discretion of the director.
 - EARLY TERMINATION: If a member is moving or needs to withdraw membership prior to the Fall 2024 session, written notice is required. Upon withdrawal, 50% of September's dues will be refunded since curriculum materials had already been ordered for that child.

Beyond the Books reserves the right to accept, reject or terminate a family (or learner) that is not in the best interest of the program. Every reasonable attempt will be made to connect the family with a facility that is better suited for the child's needs in the least restrictive environment.

Membership Agreement/Waiver Form

Overview: I do hereby apply for membership in Beyond the Books Education. With the signing of this membership agreement, I accept the offer made to become a member of Beyond the Books and have read and agree with everything presented to me in the handbook and agree to the following:

Declaration of Purpose: The purpose of Beyond the Books is to operate a private education program for families who wish to homeschool their children but for many reasons are unable to do so. As a member of Beyond the Books, your privacy and choices will be respected. We are dedicated to the education of the whole child and the right of the family to determine the course of that education.

Beyond the Books founders and Beyond the Books Members (parents and children) can freely share, discuss, and exchange information and services by members of Beyond the Books while keeping all business within the private domain.

Membership: By consenting to the Membership Agreement provided, members are granted the following rights and benefits:

• Right to detailed informed consent about the services rendered, and what to expect.

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- Guarantee that all personal information of the Member will remain within Beyond the Books.
- Membership with Beyond the Books will remain intact unless the member submits in writing their desire to withdraw membership or membership is terminated by The Association in accordance with bylaws.

IT IS DECLARED that we proclaim the freedom to choose for ourselves the type of education philosophy that we think best. We encourage our members to perform their own research by studying different educational philosophies for the development of the child.

Specifically, the mission of Beyond the Books is to provide a safe and nurturing environment for the child to grow and to thrive, unfettered by external pressures of the public domain. Beyond the Books will utilize experienced educators to provide a curriculum outlined in the specific course materials or education philosophies.

 protected and only released upon written request of myself as a member.
- I agree that violation of any waivers in this membership contract will result in a no contest legal proceeding against me.
- Other aspects of informed consent may take place in my discussions with the providers and my fellow members of the Association.
- As I am voluntarily choosing this method of education and service providers, I will
 not hold The Association or its members financially liable for any particular
 outcome.

I agree to join Beyond the Books, a private membership association under common law, whose members seek to help each other achieve better health, education, and good quality of life.

My activities within Beyond the Books Education are a private matter that <u>I refuse to share</u> with the State or local Board of Education or other governmental regulatory agency without express permission from Beyond the Books Founders. All records and documents remain as property of the Association, even if I receive a copy of them. I fully agree not to pursue any course of legal action against a fellow member of the Association, unless that member has exposed me to a clear and present danger of substantive evil, and upon the recommendation and approval of the Association.

I enter into this agreement of my own free will without any pressure or coercion. I affirm that, as a private member I do not represent any Local, State or Federal agency whose purpose is to regulate and approve products, services, or practices, or to carry out any

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mission of enforcement, entrapment, or investigation. I have read and understood this document, and my questions have been answered fully to my satisfaction. I understand that I can withdraw from this agreement and terminate my membership in this association at any time, and that my membership can and will be revoked if I engage in abusive, violent, menacing, destructive or harassing behavior towards any other member of The Association. These pages consist of the entire agreement for my membership in The Association.

Payment of any dues, fees or program costs, if applicable, and delivery of these signed documents to a BtB representative is considered sufficient for my one-time membership contract. Term begins with the date of submission of this contract.
